

# cpd25 Event Attendance and Evaluation Report 2021-22

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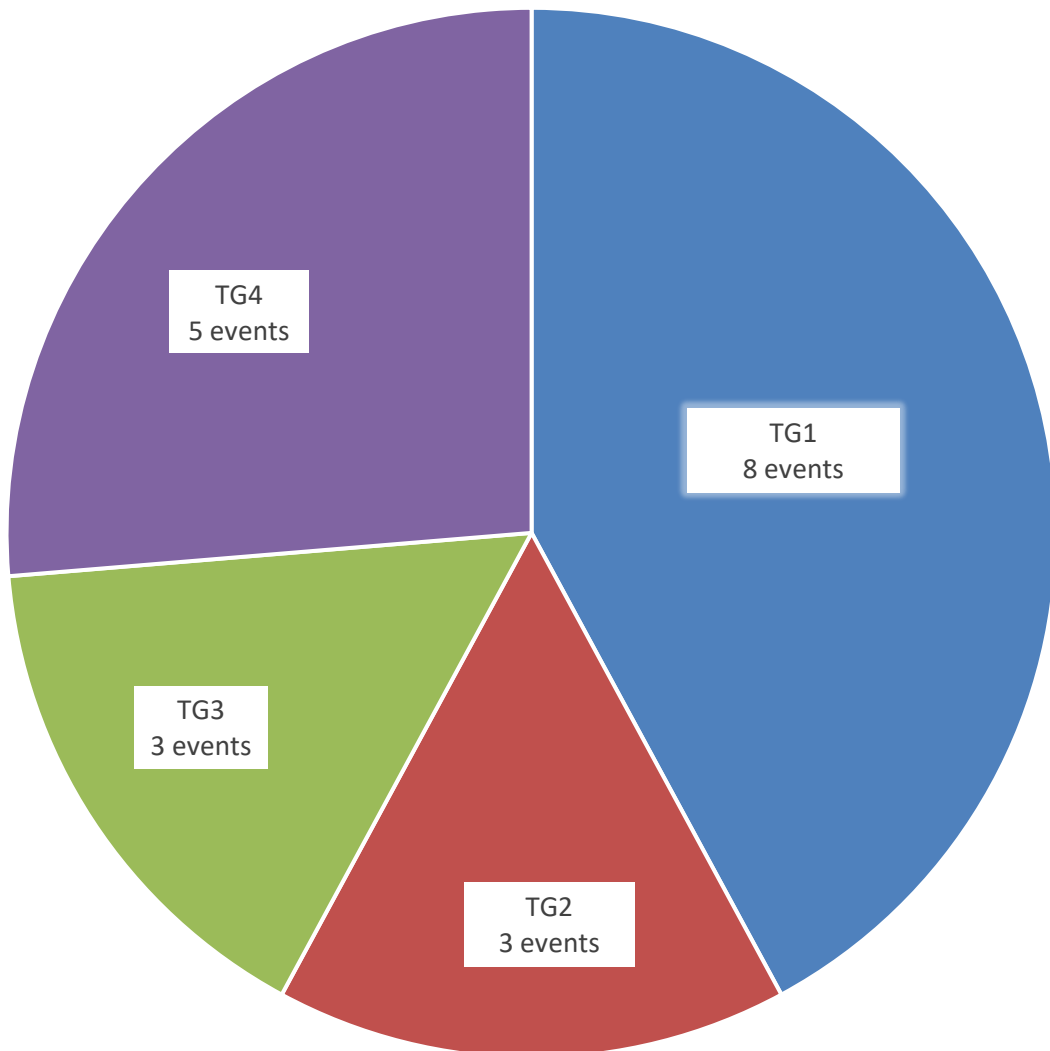
## **Event Attendance 2021-22**

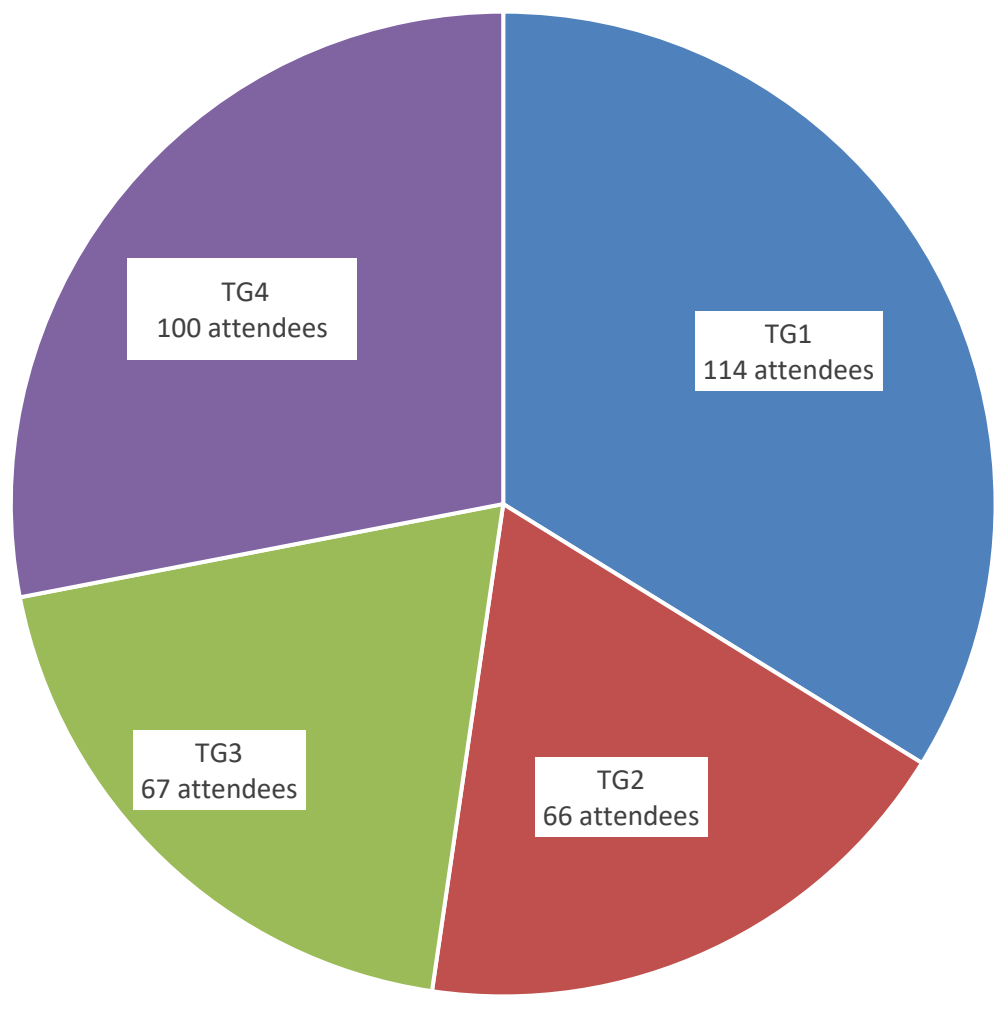

# Number of Attendees 2021-22

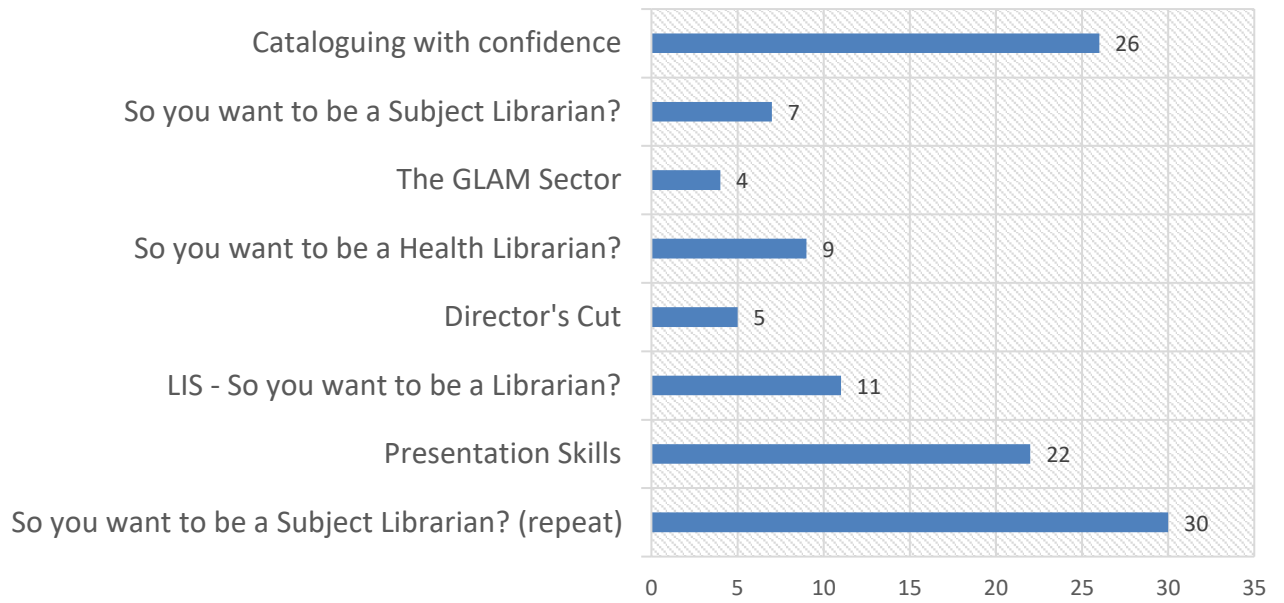

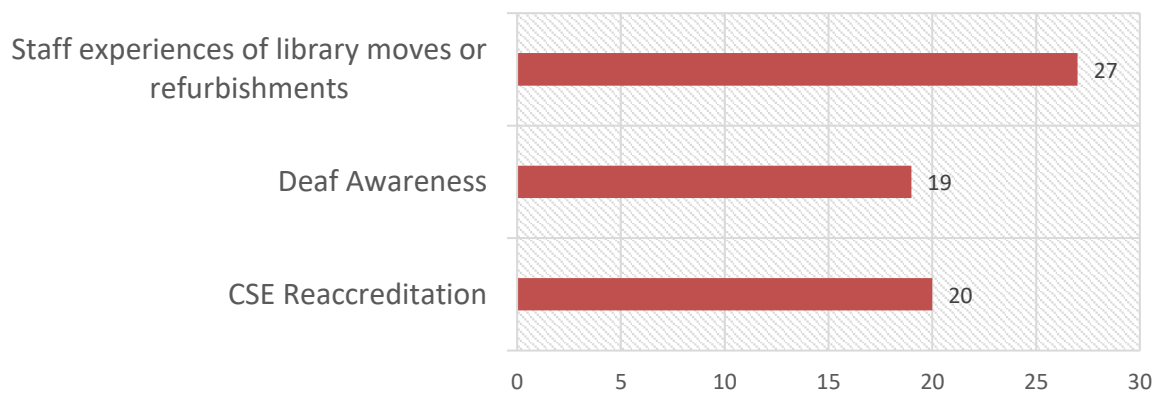
## TG1 Attendance

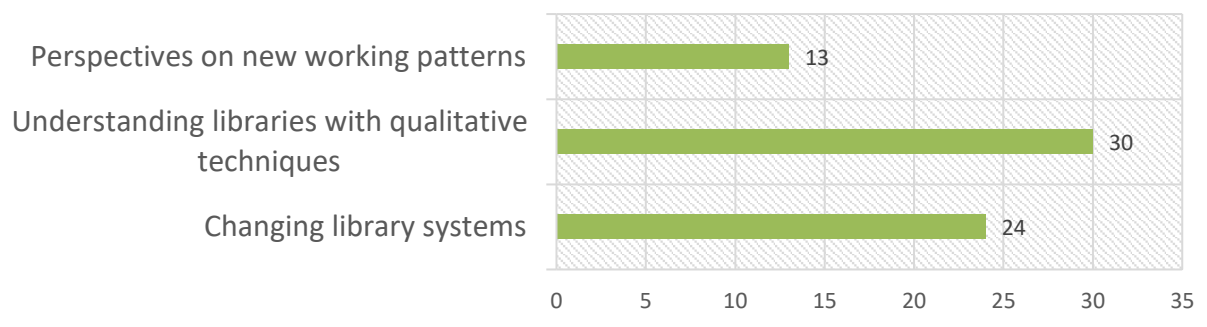


## TG2 Attendance

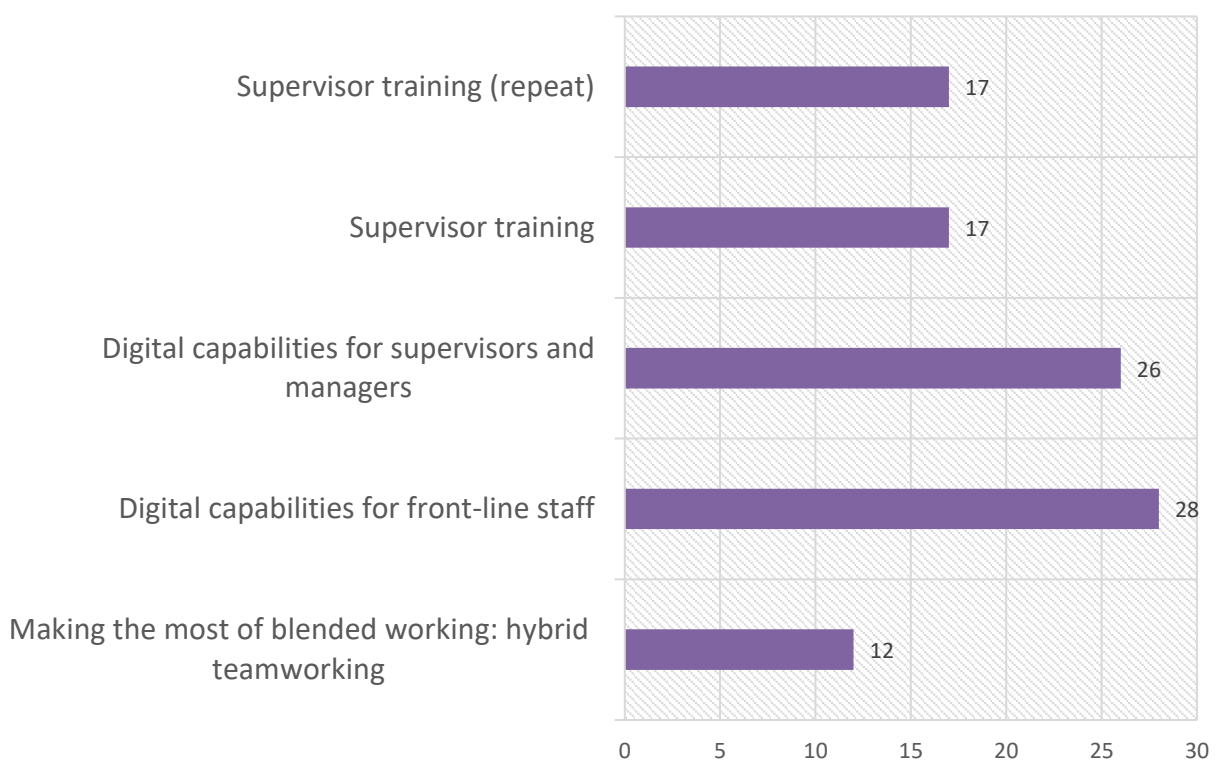

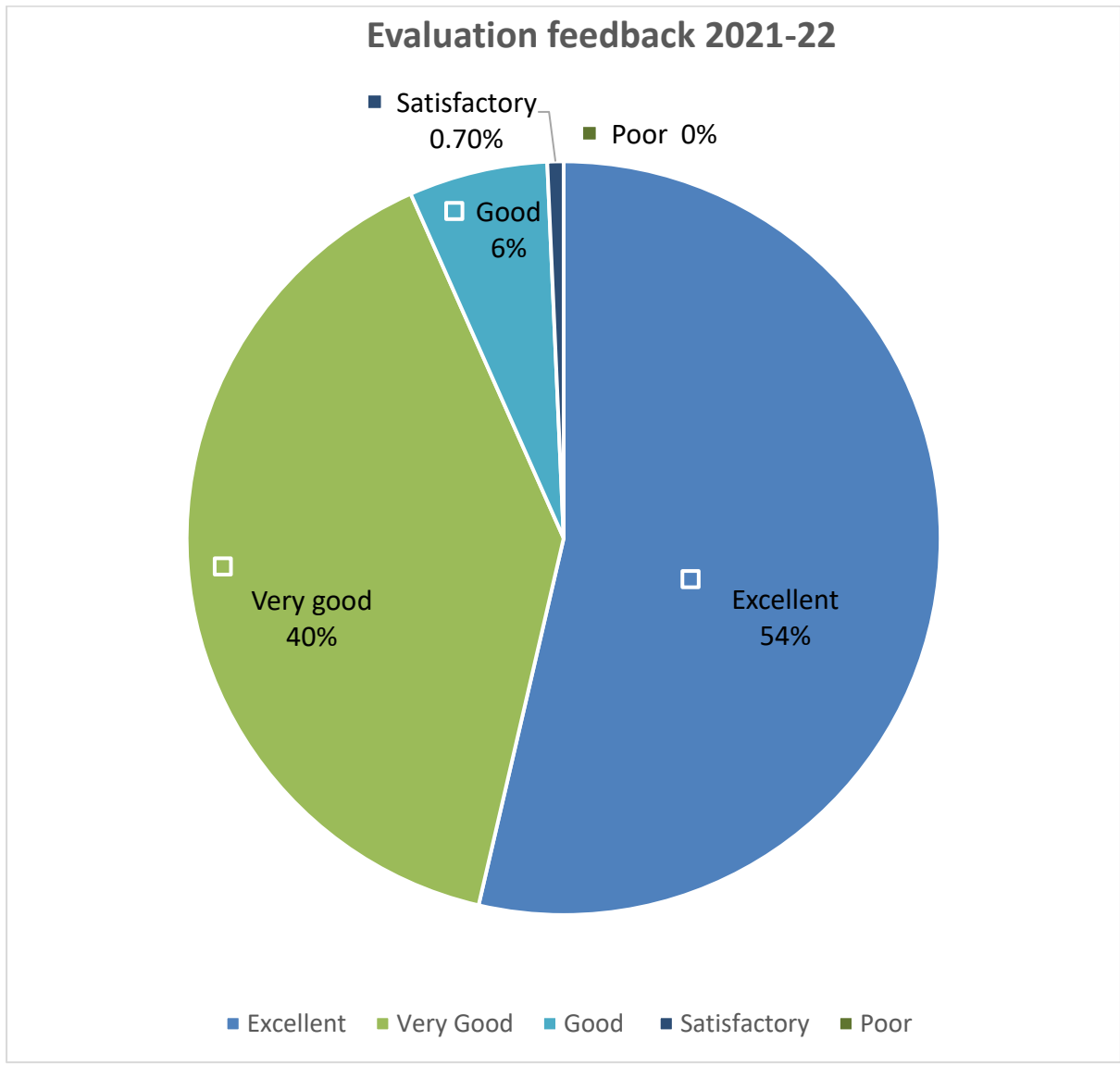
### TG3 Attendance Total 67

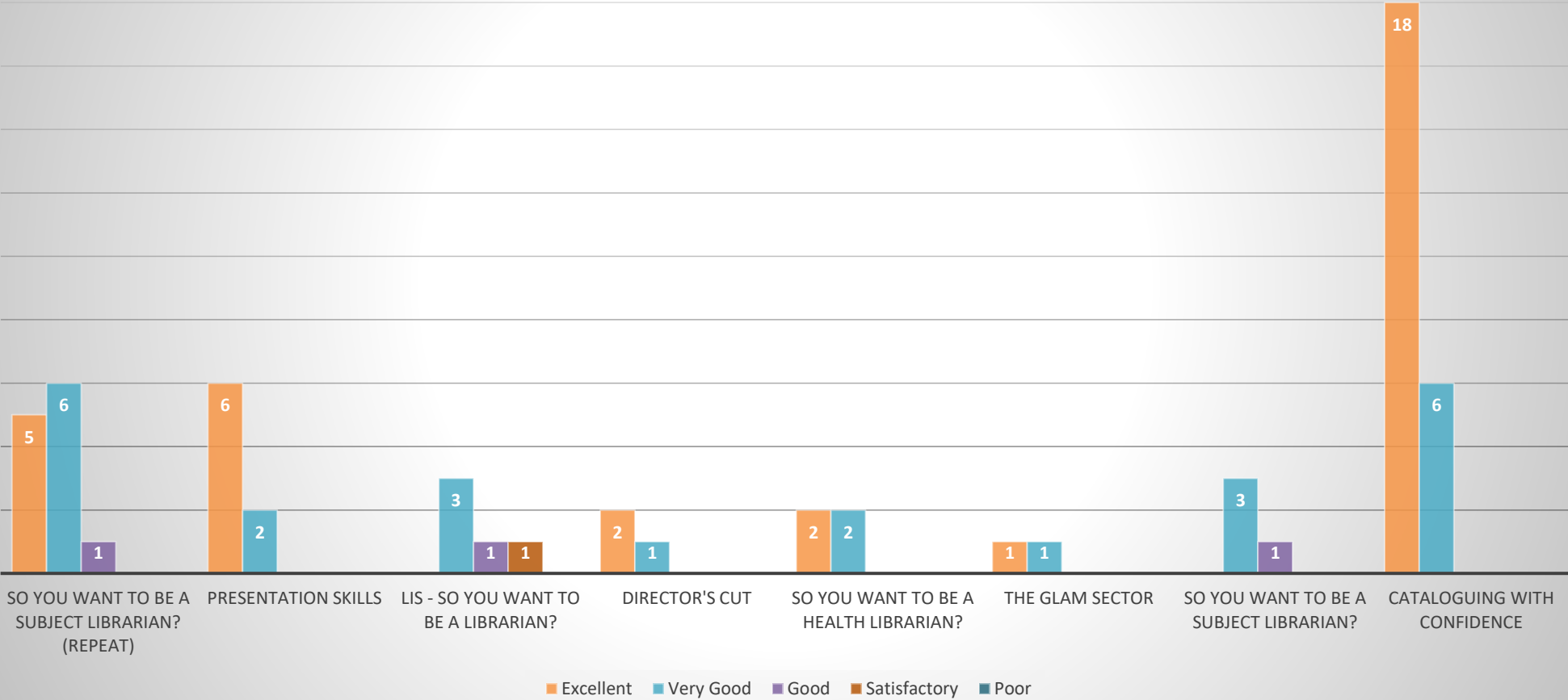

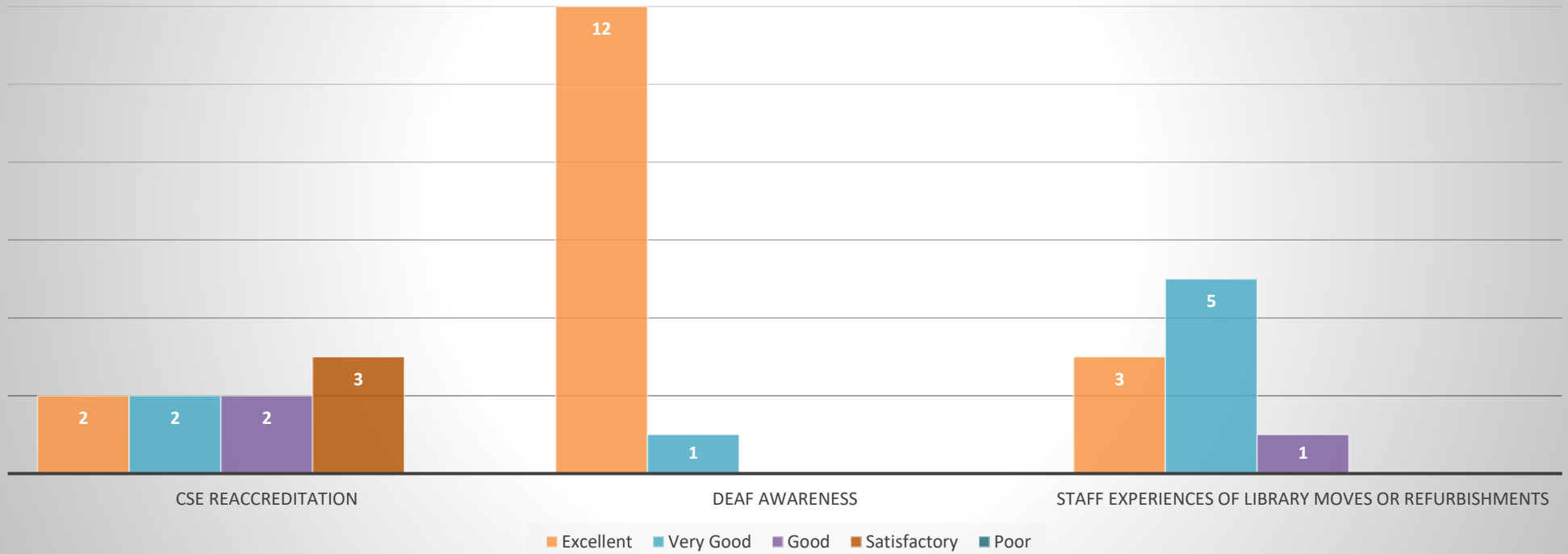

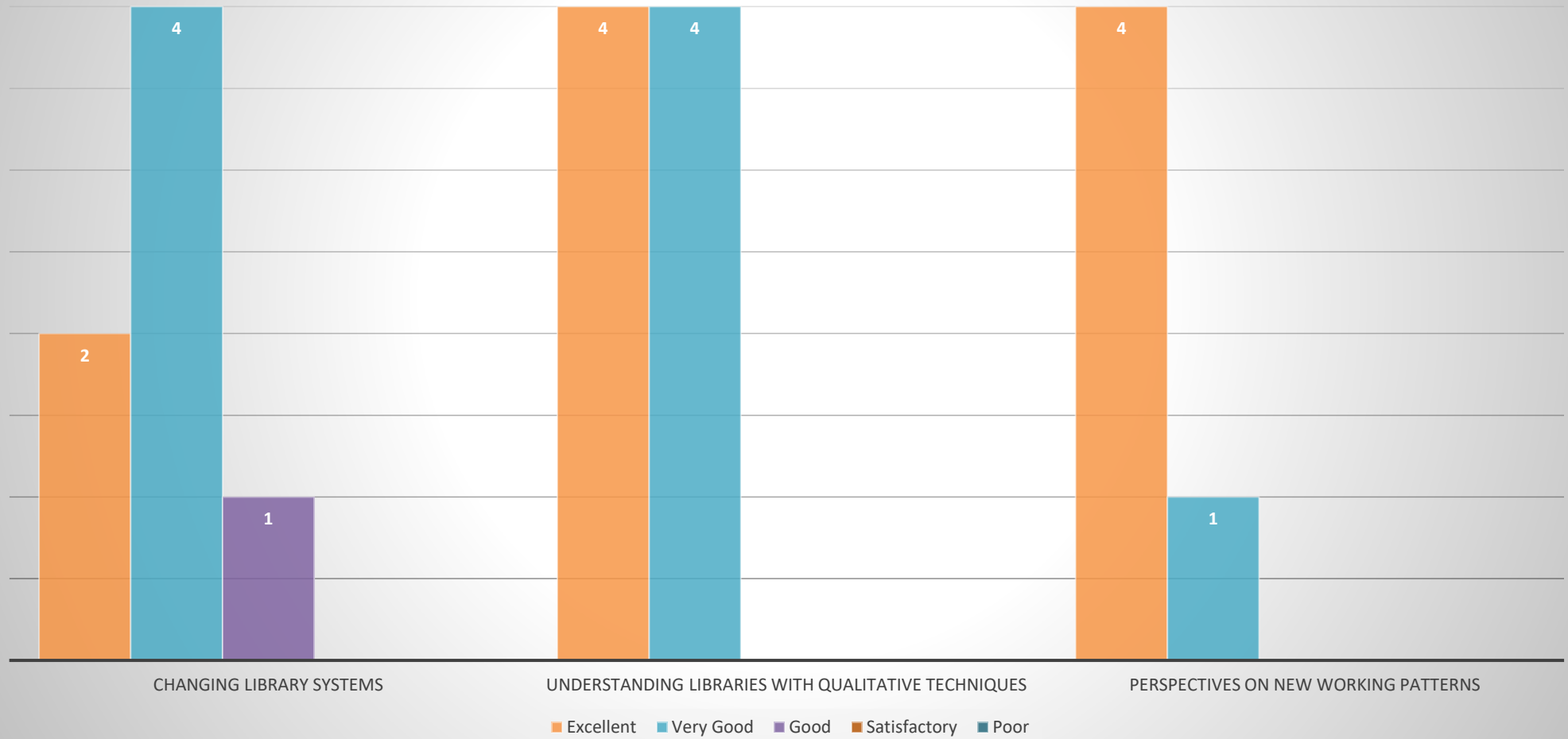
