
Staying Positive in Trying Times: Looking After Yourself

## **Staff Development Awards**

M25 Consortium's <u>Staff Development Awards</u> enable you to gain knowledge by attending a cpd25 event or the M25 Annual Conference for free.



The Awards are a fantastic opportunity for staff working in any role at any level in any of our member libraries to enhance their professional development and to network with others.

Each year there are a maximum of five Awards available across two categories:

- Free attendance at the equivalent of one full day of <u>cpd25 training</u> (Three awards available)
- Free attendance at the M25 Consortium

   this award enables an additional staff
   member to attend Conference at no cost)
